Application Instructions:

Garden Soil Preparations

Mix 40Lb./1000 sq. ft. into the top 3 in. of your garden soil in the spring before planting.

Transplanting of Vegetables and Annuals

Mix 1/2 - 1 cup in transplanted hole.

Perennials

Spread 1-2 cups around plants and work in first 3 in. Apply in the Spring and Fall.

Potting Soil

Mix 1 part to 4 parts of your potting soil or use our Potting Mix.

Fruit Trees and Berries

New: Mix 1-2 cups with your garden soil in transplant hole.

Established: In the Spring & Fall, mix 1-2 cups per 1 inch diameter from trunk out to the drip line into the top 3 inch of soil.

Roses

Mix 3-5 cups around plants and mix in first 3" in Spring & Fall.

Lawns

New: Spread 40Lb./1000 sq. ft. over entire area to be seeded and rake in.

Established: Sprinkle 20Lb./1000 sq. ft. over entire lawn surface as a top dressing during Spring and Fall.

Turf: Recommended rate: Spread at 10 to 20 lbs/1,000 sq ft or 1/2 to 1 ton/acre
